

Cost Schedule

(In accordance with the decision of the Board of Trustees of 24.11.2016)

1. Base price

The base price for every enrolment comprises the following three cost types:

Base price per enrolment: The base price per enrolment is CHF 500 per year and is borne in full by the employer. In the case of entries and departures during the year, it is charged on a pro rata basis.

Base price per insured person:

The base price per insured person is borne by the employer and the employee according to the ratio specified in the SR and is reported in the benefit and collective statements.

It is determined using the graduated scale on the basis of the portfolio of active insured persons on 1 January of the calendar year in question. In the case of entries and departures during the year, the base price per insured person is charged on a pro rata basis.

Base price for mid-year payments:

A surcharge of 1% of the insurer's risk premium is charged for the mid-year payment method. This surcharge for mid-year payments is borne by the employer and the employee according to the ratio specified in the SR.

The base price includes the following services:

- Managing the group of insured persons
- Managing the premium/contribution accounts
- Managing the retirement accounts
- Drawing up the list of premiums/contributions
- Drawing up the benefit statements
- Drawing up the annual financial statements (short version)
- Processing of changes which the pension scheme cannot make directly using the online tool
- Coordinating insured events (retirement, death, disability)
- Maintaining the BVG shadow account
- Settling payments with the Guarantee Fund
- Special additional activities such as:
 - o Implementing decisions by the Board of Trustees
 - Handling exceptions to the regulations
 - Providing data for third parties
 - o Dissolution, (partial) liquidation and establishment of the Foundation
 - o Providing information to the insured persons
 - Carrying out calculations for the distribution of Foundation funds and free funds belonging to the pension schemes
 - Calculating restructuring contributions
- Providing and maintaining an online tool with which the employer and the insured persons can make the following changes and simulations and order the following printouts:
